6. Committee Reports:
Ambulance: 54 call YTD, this is down a little from last year and they are hoping the numbers stay down. Ordered 2 new defibrillators and they are really nice machines and ended up being a little cheaper than they thought they would be.

Library: Doing good, really close to the threshold to reopen the library, probably by next week they should be able to open. They will be using the armory for the last 2 weeks in March to have a large book sale.

Chamber: A lot of people have been calling the chamber to compliment the skating rink. Alexis Baratka met with the chamber regarding the rodeo. It is scheduled from July 3rd and 4th this year.
